



Writing Phases in the Primary Classroom

Stage	Characteristics
Preconventional phase	Scribbles, mock letters, random letter strings
Semiphonetic phase	Beginning connection between letters and sounds
Phonetic phase	Close letter-sound relationships
Transitional phase	Well-developed understanding of letter- sound relationships and print structures
Conventional phase	Correct use of orthographic and grammar conventions







